Riesling, Dönnhoff, Nahe, DE, 2017 \$72

Riesling in its most exceptional form often comes from Germany.

This wine from Cornelius Dönnhoff is a wonderful example of off-dry Riesling to pair with nearly everything on the menu. Often overlooked by guests, Riesling is perfect with food due to its high acidity and fruity profile. The hint of sugar works well with a hint of spice in dishes like our fried chicken or our hot and sour halibut.

Baga/Touriga Nacional 'Baaaga Duck', João Pato aka Duckman, PR, NV \$80

Made by João Pato, the daughter of the legendary Portuguese producer Luis Pato, this wine is an ode to what Portuguese natural winemaking should be. It is light and juicy, with enough tannin to give excellent structure to the wine. The red fruit and wonderful acidity makes this an excellent pairing for many of the winter flavors on our menu.
